



THE HIDDEN VALUE OF BOARD SERVICE

It's the time of year when PPN once again opens nominations for the board of directors. Everyone knows that serving as a board member does entail a certain amount of work. What may not be so apparent is that the benefits received by far outweigh the time invested. Here's what being on the board of directors did for me.

First, I made great friendships. Yes, many of these people would have been my friends regardless, but the additional time spent together at board meetings and working at events further cemented those friendships. That extra time spent together also led to a great exchange of business ideas and information. Also, having experienced it firsthand, I know the com-

Next, serving on the board gives you opportunities to talk to speakers one on one. As newsletter editor I had conversations with some of the biggest names in our industry today. As an event chairman I continued those contacts.

The credibility aspect of serving on the board should not be underestimated. First you have had personal conversations with many speakers from other states and regions who then are familiar with your name. They may be in a position to recommend you for speaking or judging events in their state. This can be a great benefit if you are actively pursuing a PPA degree. Even without the personal recommendation, serving as a board member is another listing on your resume that will add to your creditability. Even if you are not interested in pursing a degree, speaking and judging will provide further opportunities to meet new people and continue your professional education. I always have found that when giving a program, I come away receiving more knowledge then I imparted.

Lastly, I developed many skills during my tenure on the board, which have greatly enhanced the daily running of my business. People skills are perhaps the most obvious result. You learn to deal with many diverse personalities in a group project situations. As president, you learn to manage people serving under you and assign jobs based on each person's (employees') abilities. You learn how to delegate and then follow up to ensure tasks are completed. And very valuable, you learn to let go of some jobs and concentrate on those tasks that require the president's (studio owner's) attention. Perhaps the personal skills I had to develop are the most valuable things I took with me from my tenure on the board. Time management has always been a difficult issue for me. Serving on the board forced me to develop that ability. Also, with time management came the concept of prioritizing tasks. Both of these skills are crucial in a small business setting.

If you are looking for an effective method to improve your business through personal growth, I strongly encourage you to consider serving as a PPN board member. The friendship and fun make every minute devoted worthwhile, but that's just the tip of the iceberg as far as the benefits of board service are concerned. When I or anyone else asks you to accept a nomination, please say yes! You will be glad you did.




Monte Evans CPP, Cr.
